

## STYLESHEET

Footnotes should be kept to a minimum. References should be given parenthetically within the body of the text by author/date thus:

(Miller 1992: 36)

Subsequent references can be shortened, where appropriate, to page number only.

References should be keyed to a Works Cited at the end of the article, using the following format:

**(a) For books in their first edition:**

**(b) For books in a subsequent edition:**

**(d) For translated titles:**

De Beauvoir, Simone 1988. The Second Sex, trans. by H.M.  
Parshley, London: Pan

Eco, Umberto 1983. The Name of the Rose, trans. by William  
Weaver, London: Secker and Warburg

**(e) For pieces within printed books:**

**(h) Manuscripts**

Give details of the repository, collection, and manuscript referred to using the names assigned by the repository's classification system. E.g.,  
British Library, Cotton MSS, Caligula D. III, fol. 15  
Public Record Office, Home Office, HO 42/96

Where two or more works by the same author published in the same year are listed, they should be distinguished in the bibliography (and in references) by adding letters to the year date, thus: 1992a, 1992b, 1992c.
