Proposals for individual papers and panels should be delivered by email, post or fax to the conference organiser **by 31st January 2012**; they should not exceed one page and must include a provisional title, and full contact information.

Proposals from postgraduate students are particularly welcome. The cost of registration will be kept to a minimum for postgraduate students, and travel bursaries may be available.
